## HUNTING EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING LIST - WILDERNESS

**Recommended personal gear for wilderness trips. Weather may vary during the hunt from very warm to cold and snowy. It is different every year, so it is best to be prepared for everything. We recommend the layered system of dressing.**

- 1 pair of comfortable camp shoes
- 1 pair of warm, water resistant hunting/hiking/riding boots—we recommend Schnee's or Sorrel boots
- Extra felt liners for boots
- Wool socks—at least 4 pairs
- Plenty of cotton or regular socks
- At least 2 complete changes of clothes
- 2 pairs of long underwear
- personal toiletries (toothbrush, glasses/contacts, personal medications etc.)
- WARM SLEEPING BAG and Pillow
- warm coat (we recommend wool)
- light coat
- warm cap with ear flaps
- two pairs of gloves
- hunter orange vest (at least 400 sq. inches)
- hunting pants (wool, gortex lined, or other water resistant material)
- large caliber rifle with sufficient ammo (300's are good)
- HUNTING LICENSE
- binoculars
- sunglasses
- sunscreen
- flashlight or headlamp
- rain gear
- water bottle

### OPTIONAL OR LUXURY ITEMS

GPS, Range Finder, Cell phone  
Camera/extra film  
Spirited beverage if desired

**\*\*\*LIMIT WEIGHT OF GEAR TO 50 LBS OR LESS IN DUFFEL BAGS AND KEEP MULTIPLE BAGS EQUAL IN WEIGHT.**
